+ Affirmative

I	am / 'm	I am a student.

- Negative

I	am not	I am not a vet.
You We They	are not aren't	You / We / They aren't cousins.
She He It	is not isn't	She / He / It isn't young.

? Interrogative

Am	I	Am I happy?
Are	You We They	Are you / we / they relatives?
Is	She He It	Is she / he / it hungry?
